Tip: put your most important question first. You may not get to all three, and that's okay.

What my lawyer thinks I should also weigh

Biggest risks or unknowns they flagged

Realistic range of outcomes, not just the best case

BEFORE YOU LEAVE

don't skip this

My next step, in one sentence

What I'm doing before we talk again

What my lawyer is handling

What has to happen before the next milestone

Our next check-in date
