

Shared Custody and Visitation Checklist

You have your child(ren)'s best interests at heart and you want them to feel safe, secure and well cared for every time they visit. This checklist will help you make sure you're providing for their needs every time they visit.

If all of the above apply to you, then you can now file what is called an Uncontested Judgment. It is called an "Uncontested" Judgment because you and your spouse have not needed to litigate (i.e. go to trial) to resolve the issues in your case, and have instead reached full agreements that you would like the Court to enter as an order.

Basic Needs

- Bedroom:** bed, sheets, pillow, closet, hangers, storage space, pajamas, spare clothes/shoes, spare coat(s), hats and other cold weather gear
- Bathroom:** toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, towels, band-aids, sunscreen, bug spray, first aid kit, children's pain/cough/cold/allergy medicine (tip: check expiration dates quarterly), hair styling equipment (hairdryer, curlers, gel, hairspray etc.), shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, etc.
- Kitchen:** bottles/sippy cups, frozen breast milk and/or formula (tip: make a system to track expiration dates for open packages), children's eating utensils/bowls/plates, and your child's favorite snacks (list below):
